

## ATUS Exercise: Measuring Time with Children

## Summary

There are multiple ways to measure time with children using time diary data from the ATUS. Things to consider include whether you want to measure primary activities, secondary activities, or co-presence. For primary activity — does this include direct childcare of both household and non-household children? For secondary childcare — does this include secondary care of all children, household children only, the respondent's own children? For with children — does this include own children or any children under 18 and does it matter if they are co-resident or not?

Part 1: Create Measures of Childcare
Create different measures of childcare of own household children and see how they compare for parents with a co-resident own child under 18 (KIDUND18) using 2015 data. Include at least the three following time use variables in your extract (make more if you want to see how different variants compare): 1) time with own children under 18 (co-presence filter); 2) time providing secondary care to household children (secondary childcare filter); 3) time providing primary care to household children (activity filter; activity codes 0301xx, 0303xx).
1. Which measure provides the highest average time with children?
2. Which measure provides the lowest average time with children?
3. Explain the differences in the primary childcare, secondary childcare, and with children measures
